

**TVT Trail Ride to Golden Gate National Recreation Area – Marin Headlands  
Sunday July 9, 2017 Arrival 9:00 Ride out at 10am SHARP! Penny Marrs Trail  
Boss**

Loop 1 – Moderate, open trail and roads, bikes and hikers, lots of up and lots of down.

- Approximately 7– 8 miles. Horse must be able to do long haul climbs and downhills. 360° view of City from top. This loop will only be chosen if we have riders who's horses are less in condition. But if you have not done real hills recently, GGNRA is probably not for you....

Loop 2 – Difficult, lots of single track, with many hills, bridges, various footing, bikes, kids, strollers, ocean noise, dogs on leash.

- Approximately 12-13 miles. This is a new loop, TVT has not done this recently. Miwok to Old Springs, down Tennessee Valley Rd to Coastal Trail crossing onto Pirates Cove Trail overlooking the ocean, then back up Coastal to Fox Trail, home via Old Springs, Miwok, and back to the parking lot. This will be a fast walk trip with trot only if everyone agrees. Horse should be in good to excellent condition, able to handle steep up and downs, similar to Muir Beach Trails or Pt Reyes/Stewart Ranch to Wildcat Beach.

This will be an all day event, planning to be back at parking lot by 3:30 to 4 pm. Directions from Brentwood:

- Hwy 4 West to I-80 South, 38.5 miles
- Take Exit 20 ie Richmond Parkway to 580 West crossing the Richmond Bridge... \$20 Bridge Toll
- Take Sir Francis Drake through Larkspur past San Quentin to 101 South
- 101 South going 16 miles to Exit 442 towards Sausalito going about 128 feet....
- Turn Right onto Alexander Avenue seeing signs for Sausalito for about .3 mile
- Turn Left onto Bunker Road. You will come to a tunnel

before entering the park. It's a one-way tunnel so you must wait for a green light to enter. It's short, and historic.

- Continue on Bunker Hill Road to the parking lot opposite the Horse Barn that's on the left side of the road. Can't miss it...its BIG. Be sure to lock trailers & trucks and carry all valuables with you.

Directions from East Bay, Livermore, Pleasanton, San Ramon:

- I 580 or Highway 24 to Richmond Bridge:
- Follow above Directions..... Return Direction from the Park
- Head Northeast on Bunker Rd towards McCullough Rd,
- Turn RIGHT on Alexander Avenue .2 mi
- Turn LEFT to merge on US-101 North towards

Larkspur taking exit 450B towards Richmond Bridge/1-580 To Brentwood:

- Take I-580 to Exit for Richmond Parkway, continue on Richmond Parkway to I-80 to Hwy 4 junction East To East Bay, Livermore Pleasanton:

- Continue on I-580 to your home destination.....
