

TVT CLUB RIDE Alameda Creek Regional Trail Sunday May 6th

Be ready to ride out at 10am.

Bring a lunch and drinking water, and if you have a container, bring water for your horse as there is no water in the staging area or on the trail.

Is your horse not conditioned but you still want to ride? This easy club ride is designed with those in mind. The trail follows the banks of Alameda Creek in Southern Alameda County near the base of the Dumbarton Bridge westward to San Francisco Bay. Long ago the creek's rushing waters provided a valuable resource for the Ohlone Indians who first settled in camps and villages along its bank.

We will only be riding the **unpaved north-side trail** from the defunct Alameda Creek stable staging area. It is a completely flat gravel trail (bring boots) and registers 3.91 miles one way. We will ride out and back on the same trail stopping to eat lunch on the return.

It takes approximately one hour from Brentwood to reach the staging area.
